**About the Awards:**

The SDHBA 2019 Awards Program will recognize outstanding achievements by association members.

Winners will be announced at the summer Board meeting August 16, 2019 and plaques will be handed out November 2019 at the South Dakota Annual Banquet in Deadwood, SD. Winners are not required, but are strongly encouraged, to be present at the Convention.

From the entries submitted from across the State, only one will be judged the winner. Projects are not to be nominated for an award which they have won in the past.

**Rules & Information:**

1. Candidates must be a member in good standing with the Home Builders Association.
2. An individual or project winning an award shall not be resubmitted for the same award for a period of 3 years.
3. The current SDHBA President shall not be eligible to receive the Builder Member of the Year Award or the SDHBA Board Member of the Year Award.
4. Use only the enclosed application or copies of the enclosed. A candidate may attach a resume to answer some of the required information, however no other material will be accepted or considered in the judging, except for Project of Year Entries.
5. Applications become the property of the SDHBA and cannot be returned.
6. **All entry forms (filled out by nominees with assistance from their local) must be received by Friday, July 19, 2019.**
